- Supervise and oversee program and drop-in participants in the climbing wall
- Assist with belaying during birthday parties and rentals
- Instruct climbing wall programs for children, youth and adults
- Ensure the safety of all participants
- Provide new guests and members with Climbing Wall Orientation
- Provide belay tests to those participants with previous climbing experience
- Provide excellent customer service and climbing wall information to our customers
- Belay during open climbing hours

Administrative

- Take daily attendance of program participants
- Prepare written/typed lesson plans for each program
- Attend any staff meetings/additional training
- Maintain written record/reports as necessary
- Answer any public inquires and/or complaints
- Ensure that waivers are filled out correctly
- Administrative duties as required

- Maintain activity areas to ensure cleanliness and safety
- Ensure consent forms have been signed for appropriate programs
- Maintain and inspect equipment

Physical/Psychological Demands

- Ability to work in a fast-paced noisy environment
- Ability to work inside as well as outside when required
- Ability to lift 20-25 lbs on a daily basis
- Must be able to belay for long periods of time
- The successful candidate must hold high ethical standards as they are working with a vulnerable population and has access to confidential information
- Remote working not available for this position

- Climbing Gym Instructor (CGI) Level 1, or current CWI Certification from the CWA
- Current Standard First Aid/CPR/AED certification
- Minimum 2 (two) years indoor or outdoor climbing experience
- High 5 is considered an asset
- Must be of 18 years or older
- Proof of Vaccination required

Work Term

- Mandatory Training June 25 - 30 – various hours
 - Climbing Camps take place July 4- August 5, 2022 (5 weeks minimum with hours available the rest of the summer if desired)
 - Primarily Monday – Friday; and evening work may be required. Hours may vary depending on program registration
 - Opportunity to continue on Permanent Part-Time
