Monitor the skatepark to ensure rules are followed. Engaging all users of the skateboarding park. Encouraging community togetherness and involvement, promoting the sport of skateboarding. Participate and help organize special events for skateboarding.

- Daily interaction with children, youth and adults at the park area

- Maintain a clean and safe park for all youth and adult visitors
