POSITION TITLE: Recreation Program Leader in Training – Summer Day Camps

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

A Recreation Program Leader in Training is to assist in providing quality leadership for a variety of preschool, children's and youth programs here at Westside Recreation Center. This hands on position will deliver a fun and safe environment for participants to explore physical literacy, fundamental movement skills as well as structured and unstructured play. This position might be funded by the Canada Summer Job grant.

Responsibilities:

- To assist in the supervision, leadership and instruction of a group of preschool, children and/or youth in a sports, fitness, arts/culture, recreation or day camp setting
- To assist in the development of lesson plans based on pre-set goals and objectives
- To actively and enthusiastically participate in programs
- To assist with the set-up and take-down, as well as general maintenance of equipment and the facility
- To ensure the safety of all participants involved in the program
- To be aware of emergency procedures (risk management)
- Mentor volunteers

Administrative:

- Take daily attendance of program participants
- Prepare written/typed lesson plans for each program
- Attend any staff meetings/additional training
- Maintain written record/reports as necessary
- Answer any public inquires and/or complaints
- Administrative duties as required

Risk Management:

- Complete Incident Report Forms as required
- Maintain activity areas to ensure cleanliness and safety
- Ensure consent forms have been signed for appropriate programs
- Follow all general facility rules related to general behavior, demeanor, use and care of facility areas, criminal activity
- Maintain equipment
- Perform first aid as required

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Current Standard First Aid/CPR/AED certification
- Minimum of two (1) year of recreation leadership and day camp experience
- High 5 is considered an asset
- Valid Vulnerable Sector Search required
- Proof of Vaccination Required
- Must be at least 16 years of age

SKILLS REQUIRED:

- Ability to work in a large team environment
- Ability to work independently
- Ability to lead large groups
- Good customer service skills
- Good communication and problem-solving skills
- Good planning and organizational skills

PHYSICAL/PSYCHOLOGICAL DEMANDS:

- Ability to work in a fast-paced noisy environment
- Ability to work inside as well as outside when required
- Ability to lift 20-25 lbs on a daily basis
- The successful candidate must hold high ethical standards as they are working with a vulnerable population and has access to confidential information
- Remote working not available for this position

EMPLOYMENT TERM

- Camps take place July 4- August 26, 2022 (8 weeks)
- Primarily Monday – Friday; and evening work may be required. Hours will vary depending on program registration.
